

LAS VEGAS REGION SCCA SUPPLEMENTAL REGULATIONS 2011

Revised 2-3-2011

- 1. All Classes** recognized by SCCA for Solo2 National competition as of February 1st, 2011 are eligible for LVR-SCCA regional competition.
- 2. Ladies Classes** LVR shall run parallel ladies classes for all classes referenced in item 1 above.
- 3. Scoring of Points for Year End Awards** LVR shall use the following formula for scoring points: 1st = 10, 2nd = 9, 3rd = 8 then 7,6,5,4,3,2,1.
- 4. Dropping events:** For every 6 events, one event will be dropped.
- 5. Top Time of Day (TTOD)** will be scored for each event and the top ten places will be published as part of the results. TTOD year end awards will be awarded to the top three positions.
- 6. Top Time of Day PAX (TTODPAX)** will be scored for each event and the top ten places will be published as part of the results. TTODPAX year end awards will be awarded to the top three positions.
- 7. Top Time of Day Ladies PAX (TTODPAXL)** will be scored for each event and the top ten places will be published as part of the results. TTODPAXL year end awards will be awarded to the top three positions. Note: there are no special PAX/RTP index values for ladies classes, so the open class values will be used to score the Ladies classes.
- 8. Class Awards:** In order to qualify for a **class award** a driver must participate in **six** events during the 2011 Autocross season. All six events need not be in a single class. A driver must participate in **four** events in any one class in order to qualify for an award in that class. (Example: A competitor runs four events in AS and four events in BS, this competitor would be eligible to win an award in both AS and BS if the competition in those classes warranted a trophy. He has exceeded the six event minimum overall requirement and he has met the four event class minimum requirement.) This paragraph is subject to the limitations of paragraph 9.
- 9. Depth of Awards:** The depth of awards shall be at the discretion of the SOLO Chair. He/she shall consider the number of total participants in any class as well as the depth of competition in that class.
- 10. Permanent Number Policy** for LVR, SCCA: All permanent LVR club members are eligible to be assigned a permanent number. New numbers will be assigned on an as available basis. Duplicate numbers will not be assigned. Permanent LVR members may choose any number between "0" and "2000" excluding "600 thru 699". The number block of 600 thru 699 is reserved for Weekend Members and will be assigned on a temporary basis by the Registrar at each event. All temporary number assignment (600 thru 699) will be assigned for a single event only. The LVR Registrar is responsible for maintaining the "Permanent Number Book". There will be no fee charged for the assignment of a permanent number.
- 11. Out of Region Permanent Number Policy:** Every effort will be made to accommodate out-of-region SCCA members who have permanent numbers on their cars. If possible, registration will assign their regular number.
- 12. Las Vegas Region SCCA shall run a Yearly Technical Inspection Program.** All LVR-SCCA members are eligible to participate in this program. Technical details of this program are available from the Technical Inspection Team and are posted on the web site under Yearly Technical Inspection Program.
